

HOW MUCH WATER SHOULD YOU KEEP IN YOUR CAR?



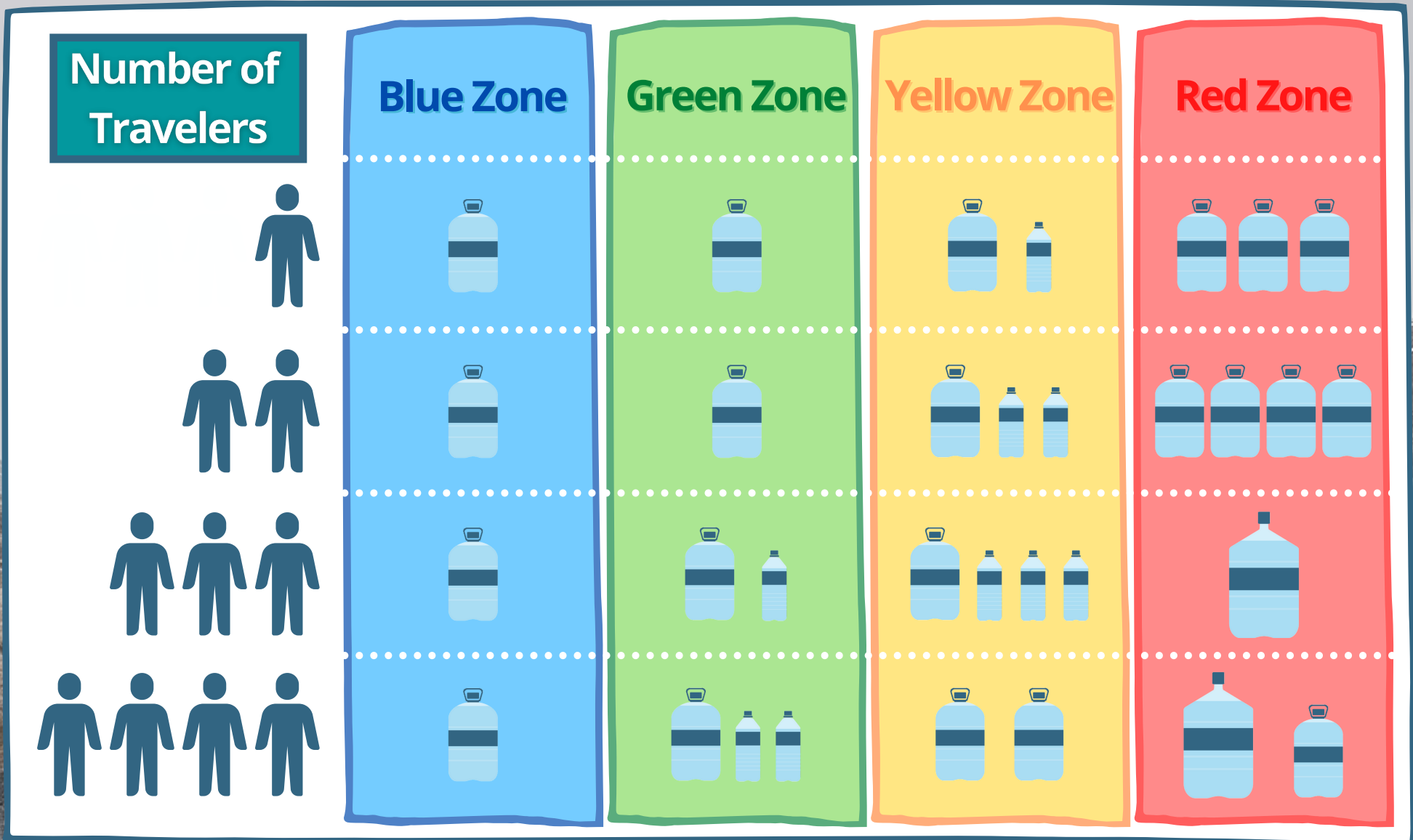
= 1 Quart

Blue Zone

- Local/Errands
- 10-mile radius from your home
- Intimately familiar routes
- Easily Walkable
- Water is available quickly if needed
- 1 gallon for up to 4 people

Green Zone

- Day Trips
- 150-mile radius from your home
- Familiar routes through populated areas
- Water is available within 25 miles of any point of trip
- 1 gallon for first 2 people + 1 quart per additional person

Yellow Zone

- Road Trips on Established Routes
- Crosses state lines, rivers, or mountain passes
- Travel takes more than one day
- Water is accessible throughout the journey
- 1 gallon + 1 quart per person

Red Zone

- Travel to off-grid destinations, or through sparsely populated wilderness
- Little-to-no cellular service
- Water and emergency services could be difficult to reach
- 2 gallons + 1 gallon per person
